



The University of Memphis Millington Center was formerly the Navy Hospital. During the Base Realignment and Closure process in the 1990's, the Navy provided the facilities to the Tennessee Regents. The University of Memphis was awarded the facilities when it made a proposal to the Regents to form a Millington Campus with the six storied tower to be appropriated for the use of "RESEARCH". Businesses looking to conduct research in a university setting need only to approach the University about the use of the facility. The proposal includes a vision of a business incubator and research tower. The Millington Center currently has over 800 students who enjoy 52,000+ square feet of newly remodeled state-of-the-art classrooms and computer lab space. The list of courses being offered expands with each semester. All six floors of the tower are being held out separate for **business research activities**.
